Thank you for taking the time to meet this morning.

As agreed, the purpose of the meeting was to provide an opportunity for Clive to consult us so we could assist him to refine his current RTI request.

After general discussion on the RTI process, information disclosed to Clive to date, and the role of the Tasmanian EPA in assisting the Victorian EPA with the Morwell incident in February this year, John agreed to provide Clive with copies of the following information with a view to assisting him to refine his RTI request:

- Presentation video compiled by John after the Morwell incident for EPA staff;
- Static Google Earth views on surveys as emailed to the Victorian EPA; and
- Plots of time series, as emailed to the Victorian EPA.

As the RTI application (number 019) has not been officially accepted there is no applicable statutory timeframe for a decision to be made on the request. DPIPWE Policy Branch will hold the RTI until further notice from Clive.
