Thank you for your letter dated the 31st July.

Yes DPIPWE sent me a DVD. This is not the DVD discovered which contains 2.16 GB of data relevant to my application.

This one holds just 706Mb of unreferenced photos and videos which are of not much use, plus press releases and press articles which are in the public domain.

Further, a quantity of files have dates that do not seem to match the time that Tasmanian EPA air officers were in Morwell in February 2014; the photos are dated mid December 2013.

Thank you for drawing my attention to the Hazelwood Mine Fire Inquiry website. I have been following this site since it was first published.

EPA Tasmania has all the air quality data and relevant information its officers gathered in and around Morwell; DPIPWE just refuse to release it. It was real-time data back in February. It is now August.
