Since the detailed review in 2011 the recommendations made have been adopted as part of industry operations using the Co-ordinated Smoke Management System.

There has been a significant industry contraction over the last three years, and a significant reduction in complaints as operational improvements based on the CSMS have taken place. The EPA also publishes its investigations into smoke events on its website.

The Smoke Management Working Group (which includes members from the Department of Health and Human Services and EPA) has not found it necessary to carry out a further full review of the existing guidelines.
