**Decision:**

A search of the Forest Practices Authority's files has identified the following information that is considered relevant to your request. The information has been examined in line with the provisions established by the *Freedom of Information Act 1991* (FOI Act) and I have decided to release all information.

**Scope of the request:**

A request under the *Freedom of Information Act 1991* (FOI Act), was received from Mr Clive Stott on 12 April 2010. The request was for:

*In reaction to the Co-ordinated Smoke Management Strategy, please release to me documentation that shows:*

- i) *The names of the participating burners for the 2008 and 2009 planned burn seasons, and*
  - ii) *The names of the participating burners for the 2010 planned burn season.*
  - iii) *The names of any other non-participating burners that have access to CSMS data.*
- i) Participating burners in 2008 were:  
Great Southern Plantations; Hobart City Council; Collins Contracting; Forest Enterprises Australia; Forestry Tasmania; Norske Skog, Gunns Limited and Parks, Wildlife Services.
- Participating burners in 2009 were:  
Forest Enterprises Australia; Forestry Tasmania; Norske Skog; Great Southern Plantations; Gunns Limited and Parks, Wildlife Service.
- ii) Participating burners in 2010 are:  
Forest Enterprises Australia; Forestry Tasmania; Norske Skog, Gunns Limited and Parks, Wildlife Service.
- iii) No non-participating burners have access to the CSMS data.
