HELP CATCH BUSHFIRE ARSONISTS BEFORE THEY STRIKE.

"Bushfire Arson: Say Something" is a new awareness campaign introduced this summer to encourage and empower Tasmanians to join with Crime Stoppers Tasmania, Tasmania Fire Service and Tasmania Police to take a stand against deliberately lit bushfires.

This campaign aims to:

- To gather intelligence around person/s involved in deliberately lit bush fires
- To raise awareness of the potential danger and devastation that these fires can cause
- Remind the community to be observant and vigilant across bushfire season

It is concerning that many of the bushfires experienced over Tasmanian summers are deliberately lit fires. A deliberately lit fire is a serious crime.

Information provided by the community may lead to an arrest, charges being laid, search warrants or become part of intelligence data. Therefore, detail is very important: the more accurate the information, the better the result.

These fires have both an emotional and financial impact on the community. People can have their homes, workplaces and possessions destroyed. Both native bush and crops can be lost. Domestic and native wildlife can perish. Volunteer firefighters leave their place of employment in order to attend deliberately lit bushfires, putting them at risk too.

Someone in our community will often have information about deliberately lit bushfires. Every piece of information helps to make our communities a safe place to be.

Help catch bushfire arsonists before they strike. Remember to never put yourselves or others at risk in order to obtain information.

Be vigilant this summer and if you have any information about a deliberately lit bushfire or about someone lighting fires, call Crime Stoppers on 1800 333 000.
