

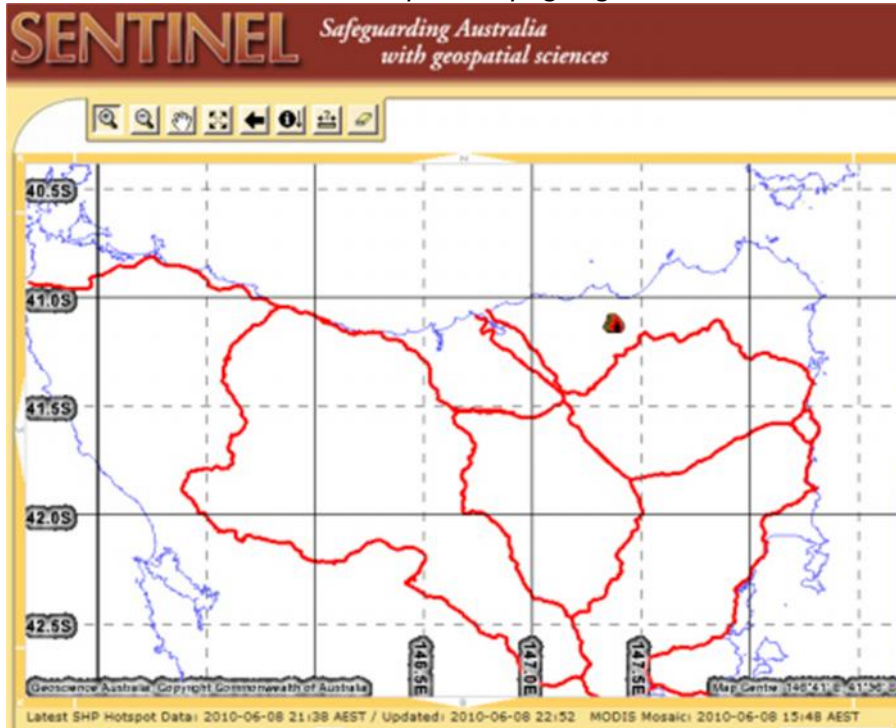

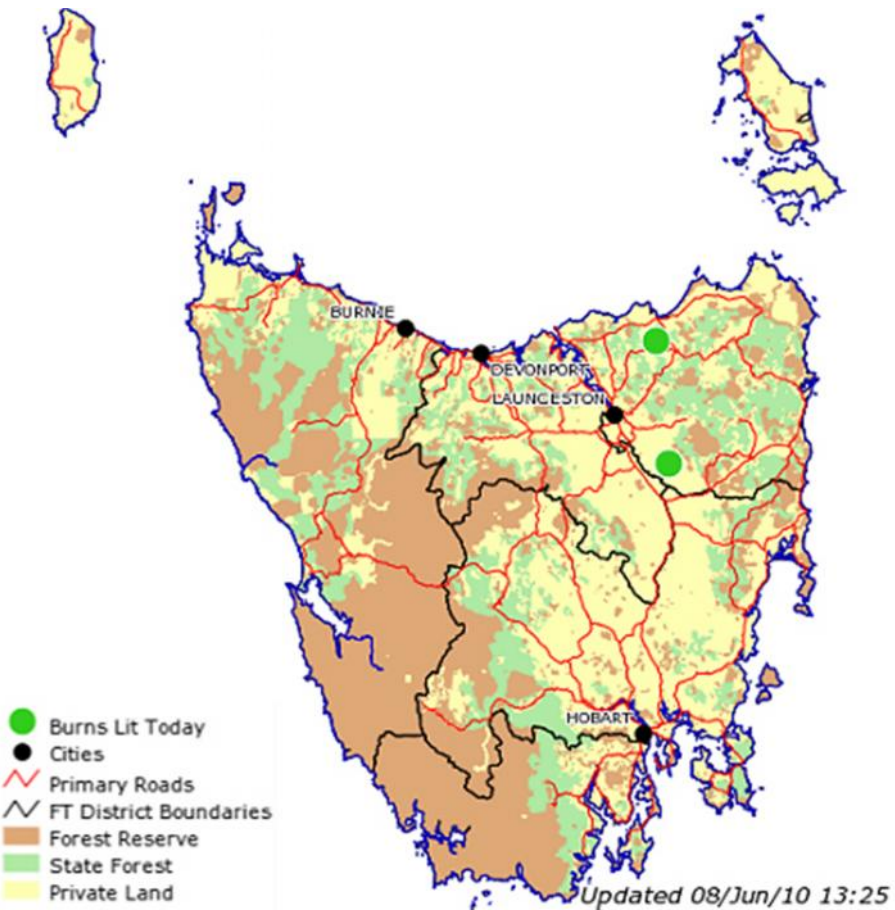
Can you imagine anyone trying to burn wood out in the open, in the middle of winter, after rain, and when more rain was predicted?
