I have to frequent Launceston the home of your electoral office when I visit respiratory specialists and many other addresses in the city. It has been acknowledged as being hazardous to health, has hospitalized me previously and left me with on-going additional health problems.

Please do not be confused by an article in the Examiner newspaper recently (20/7/2009) trying to shift the blame onto domestic wood heaters, as this article contained factual errors. Might I add that tons and tons of smoke were inhaled for many months when heaters were not even being used.

It has been determined by Sharni Driessen, advisor to Premier David Bartlett here in Tasmania that Air Quality comes under Minister Michelle O'Byrne and not David Llewellyn.

I believe there have been a large number of complaints about this pernicious smoke and I look forward to hearing from you.
