## Please note:

- All burns were conducted in HCC managed bushland reserves, with the exception of KR27 which was primarily HCC bushland reserve but also included small portions of adjoining private bushland.
- All burns were scheduled under the relevant HCC Fire Management Plans. Vegetation Management Unit (VMU) codes quoted in this document are from the relevant fire management plan-please refer to these documents for full descriptions of each vegetation management unit.
- Each burn plan is subject to an impact assessment, including potential smoke impacts.
- Where necessary, permits from relevant State departments are obtained.
- Notifications to neighbours occurs at least a month in advance, and again on the days when burns are lit.
- Dates quoted arc for the days of actual burning, and does not include the preparation, pre-burn weed control, post-fire mopping up and post-burn weed control works.
- For burns that took more than 1 day to conduct, the fire is blacked out at the end of each day and re-lit on subsequent burn days.
- Due to the wet spring in 2009 and subsequent high fuel moisture content, no burns were conducted.
- In the following section, the post-burn images can be up to 1 year subsequent to the burn taking place.
