Despite 12mm of rain 5 days ago and rain yesterday and today, #2 Waldhorn Drive, Grindelwald, were busy trying to burn again. (Refer to Smoke Watch 25/9/2011).

When these photos were taken at about 1.30 pm today it was raining and more green was being thrown on the 'fire' but all it seemed to do was make lots and lots of smoke. Wet wood does not burn.

I am sure they would have had better success getting rid of their green waste to the Exeter green waste station a few minutes away, plus nobody's health would have been damaged breathing their toxins.

The smoke was drifting around. It was rising up to the houses on top of the hill in Grindelwald as can be seen in the photos, and then at times it would blow back across the West Tamar highway. Unfortunately my health does not magically get better when the smoke stops.

This harmful smoke pollution does not comply with Tasmania's EPA Environmental Management and Pollution Control Act.
